



### APPROVED HOTEL

We are happy to advise that Sea Breeze Beach House has been inspected by the Ministry of Health and has been approved as a "Designated and Approved Hotel" to accept guests from high-risk countries.

### RESTRICTED ACCESS (REVISED)

As per the new protocols issued on the 4<sup>th</sup> January 2021, guests travelling from high-risk countries are mandated to have a second test 5 days after the date of their original test.

On arrival guests will be accommodated in the Driftwood building (Classic Poolside/Ocean View Room) until they receive their negative test result. On receipt of this result, guests will be accommodated in their originally booked room either from the day following receipt of their result or subject to availability and timing on the day of. No additional charges and no refund from any rate difference will apply.

Guests are now required to stay in their rooms prior to the confirmation of a negative result of their mandatory second test and therefore the following facilities will not be available to guests on restricted access

- Beach Area
- All Pools, Sundecks and Jacuzzi's
- Gym
- Kids Club & Teen Lounge
- In Room Spa Treatments
- Gift Shop (Items from the gift shop can be purchased through the guest services team.)

All Meals will be served via room service (no charge).

Housekeeping is conducted every three days, daily housekeeping can be requested once guests are no longer required to follow the restricted movement protocols.

### CHANGES TO GENERAL HOTEL SERVICES

In light of the recent protocols, the following changes will be made to hotel facilities once you have left the restricted access area:

The Sea Fan lap pool is now the adult-only pool, all other facilities will remain open and available for unrestricted guests.

A selection of dinner menus from all of our restaurants will be available on rotation throughout your stay. Housekeeping is conducted every three days, however, daily housekeeping can be requested,

Guests should also note that the hotel and its operation is guided by the Ministry of Health of Barbados and services may be affected due to mandatory government policies. We apologize in advance for any disappointment in disruption of our services but will endeavor to aim to provide a high level of service through this difficult time.
